In today's passage John goes over again what true belief is and he gives them some 'benchmarks of belief' so that they can be sure about their relationship with God. Are they showing genuine love to fellow Christians by helping them in practical ways? Are they keeping God's commands? And if they have a living relationship with God through Jesus are they maintaining this relationship in prayer? It's a kind of spiritual MoT and it shows John's concern and love for those he is writing to - he wants the very best for them which is to know that they have eternal life.
