# Thought for the Day: Rev Ian Ward

Who do you think you are? Our reading today tells us a wonderful truth. We are God's children! Not his servants or followers but children. God has not just loved us but he lavishes his love on us. Second, third and fourth helpings of love. Being God's children explains why we find it so hard to live in this world. Children often share characteristics with their parents, eyes, ears, nose even height and shape. We resemble our parents. So, being children of God means that even if we are not very good something of the character of God will shine out of us. If the world doesn't understand God, why should we expect it to understand us? This truth cuts both ways. We have nothing in common with the world of disobedience. We are children of God and we should live like his royal children.
