There are two ways to put a flat pack of furniture together. One of them is to get the pieces out and try and assemble them by trial and error. The result can be a rather chaotic construction with a worrying number of spare parts that don't seem to fit anywhere. When we look at what is going on around us in our world today, life can begin to look rather like that. We might at times think that Shakespeare was right when he wrote that life 'is a tale, full of sound and fury, signifying nothing'. But looking at what Paul has to say to us in his letter to the Ephesians we learn of a different story. It's one of good news for a bad news world. God is working out his pan for the rescue and renewal of the whole universe from sin, death and decay to bring order out of chaos. No wonder Paul is thrilled as he sees God actively at work in those he is writing to. He never stops giving thanks and he goes on to pray that the church will grow in wisdom and revelation to know God better, to know the hope of God's calling to be God's glorious inheritance and to know the power of God. We have good reason to join with Paul in being very thankful people
