Confident in the Gospel - Eph 2:1-18

One mark of tomorrow's Church, faithful and attracting new disciples, is confidence in the Gospel of Jesus. No Gospel – No Church! We have GOOD NEWS to share with a lost world, mis-led and confused by swirling tides of alternative truths and ideologies – with its oppressive attitudes and assertions – "the spirit of the age." How can we do this? Firstly, we need to experience the reality of Jesus in our own lives; through our own God-given faith. Personal testimony is more powerful than we might think. Salvation is freely offered to all but, ultimately, few will accept God's message; a sad reality. However, we need to be ready to share our story, "with gentleness and respect", whenever we encounter a "person of peace". Lastly, power to witness comes from our openness to the Holy Spirit; we depend on him to guide and empower God's work.
