Verse of the week:

Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptising them in the name of the Father, and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. Matthew 28:19-20a

Thought for the Day:

In our passage this week, Paul's talking to us about a mystery. Now, this isn't a mystery that we might be aware of – there are no murders to solve or escape rooms to get out of. This is a different kind of mystery. The kind that has the power to change lives. Paul tells us quite early on in this passage what the mystery is, and it's that we get to share in the goodness and the truth of the gospel because we're all members of the same body, members of the same church. What is the promise that Jesus gives us? Well, that when we reunite with Jesus, we have eternity and perfection waiting for us – and not the perfection that we might be able to understand here and now, but the type that only God can provide. Our ability to access the wonders of the gospel isn't dependent on anything we could ever do, but all through God's grace.
