- Improve welcome and opportunities for social activities for all ages to provide invitational opportunities. Welcome desk/foyer furniture ongoing; bring and share lunches reinstated; 175 quiz well attended; Band of Brothers and Women's Fellowship regular invitational events.
- Plans for reordering of building underway and fund—raising launched. Not yet done.

From last 3 years plan 2022-2025

- Church interior reordered so can be used in a more flexible way. Ongoing
- Resourcing of "detached" youth work across town and in surrounding communities in addition to resourcing of children and youth work within the church and local area/schools. Ongoing
- Partnership with church-planting churches/new church plants. Termly team meetings established with St Georges Stamford, St John's Spalding and new St Anne's Grantham plant.
- Develop links with other churches to support young disciples/interns. Ongoing. Ignite camping event included other church young people.

From last 10 years plan 2022-2032

- Become a church that resources and plants other congregations.
- Become a hub church that grows and offers opportunities to disciples of all ages.

1 Year 2023-4

- Improve welcome for all entering building, with wrap around welcome before/during/after services

- More involvement young people in services/prayer with appropriate young leaders' training
- Look at structure of services/integration of songs.
- Church weekend (away or at home)

10 Year 2023-2033

- Become a church that resources and plants other congregations.
- Become a hub church that grows and offers opportunities to disciples of all ages.

Our Goals (SMART action goals for the next year)

- 1. Reordering committee disperse information to church family and community; consultation sessions. Funding investigations undertaken and project launch date agreed.
- 2. Welcome desk in place/foyer furniture replaced/team refresh training. Continue invitational events.
- 3. Continue to encourage interest in prayer partners/triplets; prayer cards/leaflets to prompt prayer
- 4. Continue to encourage mentoring/discipleship in the autumn and to suggest all to mentor at least one other person.
- 5. Encourage cross cultural relationship and inclusion of all; training for those working with young people.
