This week the church celebrated a special day, All Saints Day on Friday 1st November. What is a saint? Have you ever met a saint? Do you think saints are alive or dead? We will be looking at 4 questions: What is a saint? How do we become saints? How do we live as saints and how do we recognise a saint? The letter of Philippians is addressed to God's holy people (Philippians 1:1) or as some translations say: to all the saints in Christ Jesus. Holy means one who is set apart for God and that simply means that we are followers of Jesus.
