Thought for the Day: David Acheson	
<p>Today we are looking at two days in the life of Jesus from Luke 4:31-44. These events come right at the beginning of his 3-year ministry, a ministry of teaching, healing and making disciples. We learn first that Jesus has authority. Verses 31-32 tells us that the people were astonished at his teaching, for he spoke with authority. The power of Jesus is much greater than the power of evil. God's word is very powerful. This is a word of power. Then we see him healing at the home of Simon Peter. The locals in Capernaum thought this was great but Jesus told them that he must also go somewhere else- to the other villages so that he could preach there also. That, of course is why he came. This good news is for the people of the whole world, and we must not keep it to ourselves.</p>
