Caught by Jesus - "Don't be afraid; from now on you will fish for people." Peter already knew Jesus as Rabbi before this incident, but this encounter with Jesus' divinity left him amazed and afraid. "Go away from me, Lord. I'm a sinful man!" Jesus settles him; "Don't be afraid," and then commissions him; "From now on, you will be fishing for people." We cannot know or imagine how God may lead us in life – we don't need to. It is enough to understand that he loves us all, with perfect knowledge, and he has good plans for us – if we will trust him. He knows our true potential and what will fulfil our destiny; each one unique, loved and valued by him; not to be clones of someone or something else. Like us, Peter made many mistakes, but Jesus never gave up on him – or on us!
